This slow and soft melody using eighth, quarter and half notes in a short repeated rhythm pattern is accompanied with right hand chords G, C and D7 and contrasting left hand single whole note chord roots. Both hands are in C position with the right hand 1 extended down to B, and left hand 4 extended to C and 5 to lower G for an ending.

Preparatory Rhythm:

Right hand coordination of eighth, quarter and half notes with left hand quarter notes in 4/4 time on C's.
