"Alleluia" is from the Hebrew hallalu-yah "praise ye Jehovah." This melody uses eighth, quarter and half notes in a short repeated rhythm pattern accompanied with right hand chords F Bb and C7 and contrasting left hand single whole note chord roots. Both hands are in Bb position with the right hand 1 extended down to A, and left hand 4 and 3 extended down to Bb and C with 5 to lower F for an ending.

Preparatory Rhythm:

Right hand coordination of eighth, half and quarter notes with left hand quarter notes in 4/4 time on C's.
